WORLD FERTILIZER TRADE IN 2010 : 99.24 M MT



There are crops growing at every corner of the world, but fertilizer plants are scatted at different regions due to raw materials mainly; To move fertilizer to where they need it, called Trade; To get it and apply in your own field, you need Finance



Changing in China

In the 1990's Chinese government tried hard to boost grain output, so fertilization was most important way to achieve this target



Chinese government had decided to increase fertilizers production by giving subsidies to raw materials, electricity etc. to producers




Fertilizer plants have been exempted from VAT

From a net importer of 15 m mt fertilizers in mid 1990, becomes an export of 15 m mt of Nitrogen and Phosphate in 2012.




Urea Capacity almost doubled to 67M MT but consumption is only about 50 M MT





DAP production increased 4 times to 21 M MT but the domestic consumption is only about 7/8 MT





Subsidy in India

Fertilizer is heavily subsidy in India



In order to reduce subsidy, Indian government decentralized the purchase of DAP in 2010, price jumped by 3 time in 3 years




Urea consumption increased as price kept the same due to control by government (subsidy)

The world has 1,387 M ha arable land. 60% of the world's available arable land is in Africa.


Enough rainfall per year to feed 9 billion people

A net importer of food, with Egypt being the world's biggest importer of wheat, and Nigeria is the world's biggest importer of tomato paste






2012 Urea Consumption in Africa ('000MT Product)





West Asia, has 313m people and 6.25m km²


